The George P. & Cynthia W. Mitchell Institute for Fundamental Physics was founded in September 2002, as the result of a very generous gift from George Mitchell. This set up an endowment to initiate the Institute. He has also given endowment for several Chairs in the Physics Department, including

- Stephen Hawking Chair in Fundamental Physics (Pope)
- Mitchell-Heep Chair in Theoretical High-Energy Physics (Nanopoulos)
- Mitchell/Heep Chair in Experimental High Energy Physics (McIntyre)
- Mitchell/Munnerlyn/Heep Chair in Observational Astronomy/ Cosmology (Suntzeff)

Additional endowments include the establishment of

- Post-doctoral Fellowship in Astronomy
- Astronomy Lecture Series
- Astronomy Colloquium Series

The Mitchell Institute hosts Workshops and Conferences, and longer-term visiting researchers. Some of the activities so far have included

- 2003: Workshop and Conference on Holography and the AdS/CFT Correspondence
- 2004: Workshop and Conference on String Cosmology
- 2004: Mitchell Symposium on Observational Cosmology
- 2004: Dark Matter in Astro and Particle Physics
- 2005: Quantum Gravity Phenomenology
- 2006: Mitchell Symposium on Astronomy, Cosmology and Fundamental Physics

Recent developments in the Institute and the Physics Department include

- Initiation of an Astronomy group: Nick Suntzeff, Lifan Wang,...
- Texas A&M is a founding partner in the Giant Magellan Telescope (funded by George Mitchell)
- Recruitment of new faculty in High-Energy Physics: Bhaskar Dutta, Katrine Becker, Melanie Becker
- Establishment of a collaboration between the Mitchell Institute and the Cambridge Centre for Theoretical Cosmology (CTC). This is funded very generously by an annual gift from George Mitchell, matched by Texas A&M University. The CTC is being set up in Cambridge by Stephen Hawking, Gary Gibbons, Malcolm Perry, Neil Turok, Paul Shellard, and others. The Cambridge-Mitchell Collaboration will host Conferences and Workshops in Cambridge and at Texas A&M; exchange visits of faculty, postdocs and students. The inaugural Conference, on *Time-Dependent Backgrounds in String and M-theory*, took place in Cambridge in August 2006
- George Mitchell has given further major funding, matched by the University, for a new Mitchell Institute building and a new Physics Department building. The Mitchell Institute will include a 200-seat auditorium, which will allow us to run large conferences at any time.





 We hope that the model of the collaboration with the Centre for Theoretical Cosmology in Cambridge will be followed with further collaborative enterprises in Astronomy, Cosmology and High-Energy physics.

 With the growing footprint of Astronomy and Cosmology in Texas, we look forward to a very exciting future...
