Writing Grading Criteria

Organization (25%):

Strong topic sentences

Focus on topic within paragraph

Clear separation of paragraphs, appropriate paragraph breaks

Points flow logically from paragraph to paragraph and within each paragraph

Arrangement of ideas, coherence, following from the introduction and

leading to the conclusion.

Appropriate use of references

Mechanics (25%):

Spelling

Grammar

Punctuation

Syntax, well-constructed, complete sentences

Word choice, vocabulary

Clear and efficient style

Satisfies length requirement
