Table of Contents (ToC):

Paper on pg. 60 – Last line of author list runs over bottom margin. Here is the fix: In `copyrightpage.tex`, please change the `textheight` from `21.6cm` to `8.3in`, to keep page v of the table of contents from exceeding the bottom margin, as follows: `\setlength{\textheight}{8.3in}`

Paper on pg. 53 – Please replace the ‘&’ with the word ‘and’ in the title. Please also fix in main matter.

Paper on pg. 143 – Please capitalize the ‘C’ in the word ‘collaboration’. Please also fix in main matter.

Paper on pg. 393 – Please remove the hyphen in the title by pushing the whole word ‘Eigenvector’ to the second line.

Main Matter:

Pg. 3 (Burkert) – There is a slight bottom margin over-run. Please fix.

Pg. 10 (Navarro/Sales) – Commas should come before super-scripts in the author list. Please fix. Also in the author list, and title running head, please replace the ‘&’ with the word ‘and’.

Pg. 21 (Governato) – The graph in Fig. 2 is very large and runs over the left margin. Can you shrink the image and push things up so there is not so much white space at the top of the page?

Pg. 25 (Elmegreen) – Please capitalize the word “formation” in the title running head.

Pg. 39 (Shlosman) – Please add a serial comma after the word “Filaments” in the title and the running head so it is consistent with the title in the ToC.

Pg. 46 (Milosavljevic/Agarwal) – The abstract is formatted incorrectly. Were macros used? Please re-format to be consistent with other abstracts throughout the volume.

Pg. 60 (Shapiro et al.) – To avoid confusion, please do not split author first and surnames between lines. Please push the name ‘Peter’ to the second line in the author list.

Pg. 69 (Hammer) – Table one runs slightly over right margin. Please fix.

Pg. 76 (Weinzirl et al.) – When more than 3 authors are listed it is standard practice to use “et al.” rather than listing all names in the running head. Please fix so the author running head reads, “Weinzirl et al.”.

Pg. 77 (Weinzirl et al.) – Table 1 runs way over right margin. Please fix.

Pg. 92 (Kormendy) – It looks like this entire page needs to be shifted down. The graph in Fig. 3 is way over the top margin and there is too much white space at the bottom.

Pg. 117 (Fardal et al.) - To avoid confusion, please do not split author first and surnames between lines. Please push the name "Arif" to the second line in the author list.

Pg. 124 & 125 (Schimovich) – Figs. 1 & 2 are slightly over left margin. Please check. Also, on pg. 125 the spacing looks awkward. (Figures too high...) Please take a look and see what you think.

Pg. 142 (Marinova et al.) – Figure 2 is placed between references. Please move this figure to be contained within the body of the paper.

Pg. 158 (Yoon/Weinberg/Katz) – Please add a serial comma after the name 'Weinberg' in the author running head.

Pg. 172 (Devereux et al.) – Please add 'et al.' to the author running head

Pg. 174 (Forestell/Gebhardt) - Please replace the '&' in the author list with the word 'and'. Please also change in the running head.

Pg. 177 (Forestell/Gebhardt) – Fig. 4 seems to be placed too high up on the page. Can you push it down? Also, Table 1 runs over right margin.

Pg. 178 (Weijmans et al.) – Commas should come before super-scripts in the author list. Please fix.

Pg. 179 (Wiejmans et al.) – Fig. 1 image is slightly over right margin. Please fix.

Pg. 198 (Khochfar) – When only one author is listed there is no need for the 'et al.' in the author running head. Please remove the 'et al.'

Pg. 217 (Robaina et al.) - – To avoid confusion, please do not split author first and surnames between lines. Please push the name 'Daniel H.' to the second line in the author list.

Pg. 220 (Robaina et al.) – In the fig. 1 caption, there seems to be a reference missing. The last line says, "Figure taken from ?". Please check this and add the appropriate reference.

Pg. 247 (Purcell/Kazantzidis/Bullock) – Commas should come before super-scripts in the author list. Please fix.

Pg. 248 (Purcell/Kazantzidis/Bullock) – Fig. 1 image runs over right margin. Please fix. Also on this page, please replace the '&' in the author running head with the word 'and'.

Pg. 254 (Koda/Milosavljevic/Shapiro) – Typically, only surname of authors is used in the author running head. This paper has fullnames . Please change running head to only surnames.

Pg. 256 (Heiderman et al.) – Please check and fix author names that are split between lines.

Pg. 281 (Kravtsov) – The title running head of this paper is too long, causing the page number to run over the right margin. Please shorten the title running head.

Pg. 287 (Madau) – Same issue as above, the title running head is too long. Please shorten.

Pg. 296 (Noeske) – Please remove author initial from the author running head. Only surname should be used in the running head.

Pg. 299 (Noeske) – Fig. 3 caption looks awkward. Can it be moved to below the image rather than to the side?

Pg. 303 (Daddi) – At the bottom of the page, there is a line that appears to be an errant footnote line. Or is that text meant to be underlined? Please look at this and see what you think. If it is a mis-placed footnote line, the fix is as follows:

FIX: In asp2006.sty, change `\gdef\tblnote@list{\@empty}` to `\xdef\tblnote@list{\@empty}` in the `\spewtablenotes` definition.

Pg. 304 (Daddi) – Fig. 1 graph extends beyond right margin. Please fix.

Pg. 309 (Reddy) – The abstract is formatted incorrectly. Please fix. (were macros used?)

Pg. 311 (Reddy) - The title running head of this paper is too long, causing the page number to run over the right margin. Please shorten the title running head.

Pg. 331 (Johnson et al.) - To avoid confusion, please do not split author first and surnames between lines. Please push the name 'Ralf.' to the second line in the author list.

Pg. 345 (Davé) – Fig. 1 caption runs way over bottom margin. Maybe if you could shrink the image that would take care of it.

Pg. 352 (Dutton/van den Bosch) – Please replace the '&' in the author running head with the word 'and'.

Pg. 377 (Alexander) - The title running head of this paper is too long, causing the page number to run over the right margin. Please shorten the title running head.

Pg. 387 (Shields/Salviander) – Please replace the '&' in the author list and running head with the word 'and'.

Pg. 415 (Photos) – Photos tend to print darker than they appear. These photos look like they are a bit dark. Can you lighten them? Please check and see what you think.

**Some figures are shifted to the left rather than being centered on the page. Please check the figures on the following pages and try using the plot 1 or plot 2 command to center these figures: 26, 58, 59, and 119.
